Hazardous weather conditions may dictate a delayed opening or a closing of the Center. It is always our goal to open our doors and remain open all day in spite of the weather, but on those days when it is not safe to do so, our policy is: When we have to delay our opening or close the Center, WHDH-TV channel 7 will list the closing or delay on their web site www.whdh.com, click onto "Weather" then "Closings/Delays" you will then see "Stormforce-Closings & Delays." As always you can call the Center, 617-773-8386, the revised announcement will be on the answering machine by 6:30 A.M. If you get a busy signal or ringing-you must wait to hear the answering machine pick-up to be certain the building has power. This is a good time to check with your classroom teachers to be sure they have current phone numbers where you can be reached in case we have to close early due to severe weather. Please keep in mind, if our Governor calls for a "State of Emergency" the Center is required to automatically close.
